

Servefest Covid-19 Guidelines

The heart of Servefest is to be the hands and feet of Jesus to our community as a testimony of His love. With that in mind, we are committed to holding ourselves to the highest standards of adherence to current guidelines regarding Covid-19 so as not to undermine our testimony to those whom we serve and to those who see us serving. In light of our current guidelines from the state and our church policies, here are our plans in order to help minimize risk of spreading illness at Servefest sites:

- We will commit to any and all recommendations and requirements that our project sites have in place on project day, as discussed by site leaders with project sites.
- Facial coverings are strongly recommended to be worn outdoors, if possible, and are required when within 6 feet of any people not in your household.
- Projects will strive to organize tasks so that there is physical distancing of 6 feet between households.
- Face coverings are required if you are indoors.
- Gloves should be worn if tools or supplies will be handled by more than one person.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided for use at project sites.
- Stay home if you or someone in your household is ill, or has been ill, in the last 24 hours.
- No community food or sharing of food/drink at project sites.
- Let your site leader know if you begin to feel ill during the project.
- Make sure to take regular water breaks and rests during service time to care for your overall health and wellness during a summer project.
